

MAKE A PALM LEAF

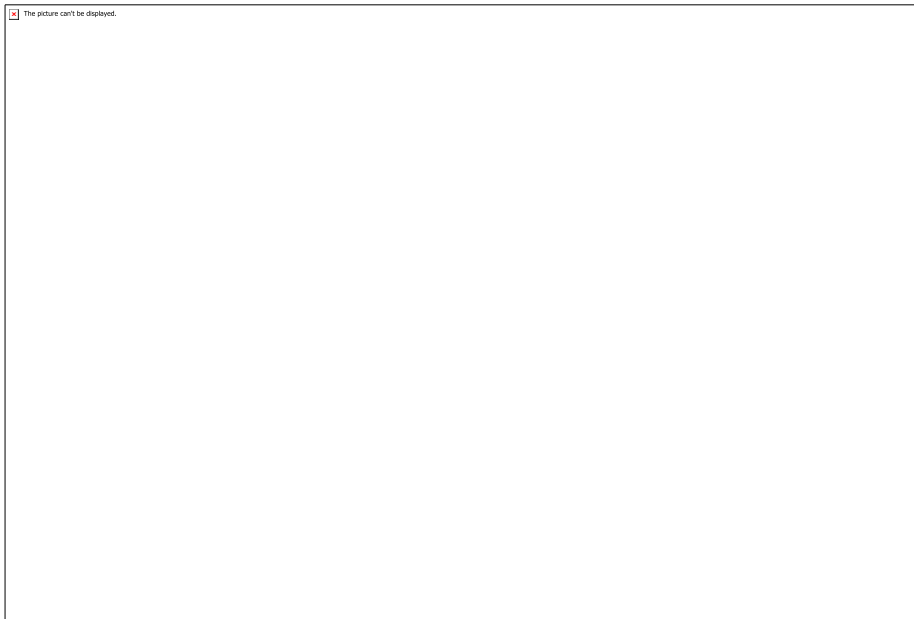
Supplies

- “Palm Leaf” handouts printed on 11x17 paper (optional) (1 per child) (download [here](#))
- scissors
- poster board
- Crayons, markers or colored pencils
- craft sticks (2 per child)
- permanent markers
- duct tape (green or brown works best)

You can use supplies you have at home. Think outside the box... if you don't have poster board, use an old file folder, or construction paper.

No craft sticks, use sticks from the yard or even pencils

No duct tape? Use masking tape.



Directions:

- 1 Download and printout the palm leaf. You can change the paper size to letter size or legal size and adjust the picture to fit the page.
 - 2 Cut-out the palm leaf template
 - 3 Trace around outside of leaf onto poster board
 - 4 Cut out your leaf.
 - 5 Color leaf on both sides using crayons, markers, etc. (or you could use green cardstock)
 - 6 Accordion fold leaf lengthwise to make it like a paper fan.
 - 7 Tape craft sticks to one end of leaf.
- Now you're ready for the parade on Sunday 😊
